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RISK DISCLOSURE

This notice has been drawn up in order to explain to the Client the key risks and potential financial losses associated with transactions in financial markets. At the same time, this document includes a list of risks, which is not complete, since other unforeseen circumstances may arise in the course of trading activities.

- 1. Trading Contracts for Difference (CFDs) carries a high level of risk and is not suitable for every investor. In this regard, the Client is obliged to make sure that he is fully aware of the financial and legal aspects of trading and is able to incur possible losses. - 4. The Client independently bears financial losses resulting from failures or failures in the functioning of information, communication or electronic systems used in the conduct of trading operations.
- 5. The Client acknowledges that under non-standard market conditions, the processing time of his orders and orders may increase compared to normal.
- 6. The Client is responsible for all losses arising from force majeure, including, without limitation: strikes, riots, hostilities, terrorism, natural disasters, accidents, fires, floods, hurricanes, storms, power failures, software failures and other events that may cause instability in the markets.
- 7. The Client should take into account that trading with a high level of risk is always associated with the possibility of both positive and negative outcomes, which, due to the influence of many factors, may differ significantly from the expected ones.
